Changes, additions or correction to entry form must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by phone will not be acceptable. An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. Refunds of \$3.50 or less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. All refunds will not be mailed out until after the show.

RETURNED CHECKS, DECLINED CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a \$30.00 fee to the amount of the check for completing the transaction and or reprocessing the entries.

Attention Exhibitors

Exhibitor Rule Change Effective 01/01/2010. Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1.

Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008. The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 event service fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (America Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). The current 50 cents recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Events Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. These event services and recording fees shall be forwarded to the American Kennel Club along with all other required event results with seven (7) days of the close of the event.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided. No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent entered a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. **THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.** Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fee may be made.

No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Show. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Event. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the Show.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 2:00pm, Wednesday, August 17, 2016. SET UP OF TENTS/ EQUIPMENTS MAY NOT BE WITHIN 15 FEET OF ANY RINGS AND NOT IN AISLEWAY. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED. Grooming will be in the livestock building located in the northeast corner of the grounds. **USE OF ALL POWER OUTLETS IS AT USER'S OWN RISK. LOADING & UNLOADING: There will be NO loading or unloading of crates/dogs at ringside during show hours! Loading and unloading** will be in the livestock building only located in the northeast corner of the grounds. Access to the Livestock Building will be off 284th Ave SE – follows signs **on Friday- gate open at 6:00am. No vehicles will be allowed on the show grounds after 7:00am on Friday unless they have reserved parking.**

PARKING INFORMATION: THERE WILL BE NO DAY PARKING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS

No practicing allowed in rings at any time. **No dogs to be left overnight in grooming building.** Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog(s). No skateboards, roller blades, scooter or bikes will be allowed on the show grounds.

CLASSIFICATION-SUSSEX SPANIELS FOR BOTH DOG & BITCHES

REGULAR CLASSES

- Puppy (6 mos. & under 9 mos.)
- Puppy (9 mos. & under 12 mos.)
- 12 mos. & under 18 mos.
- Novice
- Amateur-Owner-Handler
- Bred-By-Exhibitor
- American Bred
- Open
- Winners

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

- Veteran Class (7ys & under 10yrs)
- Veteran Class (10ys & older)

The winners of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Any veterans defeated in these classes may not compete for Best of Breed, even if entered in the class. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties shows.

Best of Breed Competition

Best of Breed Competition : The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed/Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed/Variety Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Grand Champion Competition

The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class. There are no additional entry fees or cost to exhibitors for participation in this competition at AKC events.
2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition (altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible).
4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. And their winning BOB/BOV or BOS will still allow the awarding of Select Dog/Bitch to eligible dogs in the ring.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: 1. Best of Breed or Variety. 2. Best of Opposite Sex. 3. Select Dog. 4. Select Bitch.

Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed completion and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

Award of Merit for Superior Quality: In addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, the judge may at his discretion, may recall into the ring one dog/bitch to be awarded a special trophy or rosette. This Rosette is reserved for the quality animal the Judge feels is worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed in recognition of their merit.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple dog entries)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get..

Brace Class - Effective 01/1/2005- A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only" An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class".

Sweepstakes Requirements & Classification

SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all registered dogs that are 6 months of age & under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional class".

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Puppy 6 mos. & under 9 mos.
- Puppy 9 mos. & under 12 mos.
- Junior 12 mos. & under 15 mos.
- Junior, 15 mos. & under 18 mos.

BREEDER SWEEPSTAKES

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

6-9 months, 9-12 months, 12-18 months and Open

Champions are welcome in the Open Class. All dogs must be handled in the first class by the breeder. All dogs must also be entered in a regular class. Professional Handlers are not allowed unless they are the breeder and owner of the dog.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all registered dogs that are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Entrants may or may not be finished champions. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional class".

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

- Veterans, 7 yrs & Under 10 yrs
- Veterans 10 yrs & Older

Division of Entry Money AS Prizes for Sweepstakes Breeder and Veteran Sweepstakes

35% of entry fee will be retained by PNWSSC for expenses. The remaining 65% of entry fee will be divided as follows:

PARKING INFORMATION

General Information

All parking is a privilege extended by Olympic Kennel Club and the Enumclaw Expo Center. Any arguing, abusive language or failure to follow the rules, regulations or instructions of the club or parking personnel will cause you to be escorted from the show site, forfeit all parking privileges without refund of fees and possible discipline by the Event Committee. All parking is at user's own risk. Olympic Kennel Club, Enumclaw Expo Center and J.I.F.Y.S assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.

No vehicles will be allowed on the show grounds after 7:00 am on Friday unless they have reserved parking.

- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep and leave the area clean
- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available in the general parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings.
- All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than one hour following Best In Show Sunday, August 21, 2016.
- No vending in parking areas without a permit.
- All parking fees must be paid in U.S. funds.
- Fire Lanes MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES. Vehicles subject to towing at owner's expenses with no prior notification.

Loading/Grooming Information.

There will be NO loading or unloading of crates/dogs at ring side during show hours! Loading and unloading will be at the Livestock Barn **ONLY** – gate opens at 6:00am. Grooming will be available in the Livestock and Horse Barns. **There will be NO day parking on the fairgrounds.**

Overnight Reserved Parking

Overnight parking will be handled by J.I.F.Y.S, PO Box 187, Boring, OR, 97009. Overnight parking is **\$40 per night** pre-reserved. Tow vehicles are an **additional \$30** for the whole weekend. **Checks should be made payable to OKC** and mailed to J.I.F.Y.S. There will be a \$25 charge for returned checks. Day parking is **\$5 per day**. Refund requests must be in writing and post marked on or before August 03, 2016. Refunds will be subject to a \$3.00 service fee and will be refunded two weeks after the show. **If your club wishes to reserve parking for club festivities/banquets or your group wishes to park together, requests with payment made payable to OKC** should be sent to J.I.F.Y.S. as soon as possible. It you plan on having more than one vehicle per spot, each additional vehicle will be charged **\$30.00 for the weekend** and MUST fit within your assigned space. **Note: There are no guarantees that your reserved parking will be inside the fairgrounds or close to your assigned ring. Layout and assignment of spaces will be handled exclusively by J.I.F.Y.S. – do not contact OKC regarding parking requests.**

- Vehicles illegally parked may be towed at owner's expenses with no prior notification.
- Reservations must be post marked on or before Wednesday, AUGUST 03, 2016.
- There will be an additional \$10.00 charge at the gate for those without a reservation- cash only.
- All reserved parking must check in at SOUTH parking lot. Reserved parking will be available at 2:00 pm Wednesday, August 17, 2016. MAIN GATE WILL CLOSE NIGHTLY AT 11:00 PM. ALL OTHER GATES WILL CLOSE AT 8:00PM
- Assignment of spaces will be made according to size and dimension of vehicle for best use of the parking space available. Misstated vehicle size may result in reassignment of space.
- All vehicles must park as directed by the parking personnel.
- If you wish to park near someone, reservations must be mailed in the same envelope.
- All overnight parking units must be self-contained. No dumping of gray water or sewage.
- All overnight units must have a working fire extinguisher and generator exhaust piping.
- Only One vehicle Per space unless extra parking is purchased. All extra vehicles Must fit within assigned reserved space.
