I/We apply for membership in the Pacific Northwest Sussex Spaniel Club and agree to:

- 1: Abide by the by-laws, rules, and decision of the club, and to hold the club and all persons connected with the club in any capacity whatsoever harmless from any liability, costs, and expenses for any injury or damage to persons or property caused by and the dog brought by me/us to any activity held or sponsored by the club.
- 2: Become acquainted with the Sussex Spaniel standard of the breed as approved by the American Kennel Club and to accept it as the only Standard, by which Sussex Spaniels, should be judged.
- 3: Encourage and promote the breeding of quality Sussex Spaniels and to become informed about the heritable defects, which can be detrimental to the breed.
- 4: Advance the interest of the breed by practicing and encouraging sportsmanship like competition at dog shows, obedience trials, field activities, tracking and hunting tests, and all activities in which the Sussex Spaniel may become involved.
- 5. Protect the Sussex Spaniel by never selling puppies or grown dogs to commercial outlets and never selling to puppy mills. Eligibility: There shall be two types of membership open to anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club. All applicants will need to be sponsored by two PNWSSC club members.
- I. Full Voting Membership open to all persons 18 and over. Full voting membership entitles a member to full club privileges, including voting and office holding, and is \$25.00 per person or \$40.00 per Household.
- II. Associate Membership is open to all persons nine years of age and over. An associate member is a non-voting, non-office holding membership, but included all of the other club privileges such as awards, newsletters, etc., and is \$15.00 per person or \$20.00 per Household. There is NO CHARGE FOR JUNIOR.
- III: All membership applications are to be giving to the Secretary or mail to PNWSSC P.O. BOX 35, BURLEY WA 98322-0035 IV: Before the Board and membership approve any membership application into the club, the prospective member must attend two clubs meeting or one club event. Attendance for associate membership is not required. While membership is to be unrestricted as to residence, the club's primary purpose is to be representative of the breeder and exhibitors in its' immediate area.
